W.A.I.S. MENS BASKETBALL PROGRAM

The W.A.I.S. Mens basketball team is the outcome of co-operation between Wally Foreman the director of The West Australian Institute of Sport and Craig Fitzsimmons the development officer for basketball in W.A. Their common desire to foster the development of West Australian players to higher levels of expertise without having to leave the state, as has been so common in the past, has led to our sport being accepted into the institute.

The experiment of the W.A.I.S. mens team playing in the A division of the State League needs to be backed by all West Australian basketballers because of the great possibilities the program has in developing the game. This year there will be great pressure on both the players and coaches to show that such a young team can be competitive in our top levels.

Under the control of Warren Kuhn and John Taylor, two highly regarded fundamental style coaches, the program is seeking to build a strong base for its players to spring into the forefront of W.A. basketball.

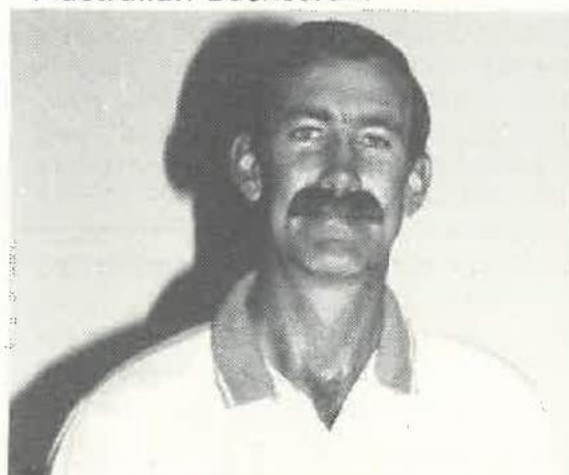
